- Have participated on a Varsity athletic team at Brentsville District High School

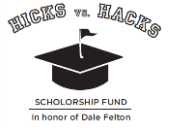

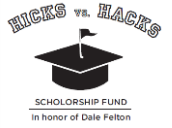

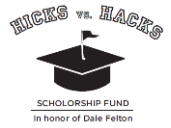
