Many students have asked me how to make up and retake tests.


I have decided to move forward with my makeup/retake plan in hopes that I won't have to retract the plan once more information is made available from the state and county.

Please Note: the following plan is subject to change based on state and county directives

Here's the plan:

- 1.) Students will complete the following google form: <https://forms.gle/8Kiz6HP7VJZxsrYv7> and tell me what they need
- 2.) Any student who doesn't fill out this form I will contact by phone to ensure that all students have this opportunity.
- 3.) I will go student by student, class by class, and provide whatever necessary makeup/retake work. I will individually contact each student and their parent to set up a testing time.
- 4.) I will send a makeup/retake to the student/parent and coordinate a timeline to have the test submitted. Students and parents will be required to sign an honor code and proctor waiver.
- 5.) Because I am essentially creating an individual learning opportunity for each student, plus making any phone calls this may take a long time, so please be patient as I navigate this new adventure.

As for continuing curriculum. I just received news that IGCSE and Cambridge courses are expected to complete the course! Mrs. Ragghianti and I are collaborating to make this work. Starting next week, we will provide notes with keys and practice problems. We will also be hosting a zoom meeting to answer questions on Thursday April 2nd. The timing of this meeting hasn't been determined yet, I'll be in contact with more details next week.
